Supported Employment Services

Type of Service	Rate
Milestone 1 - Job Development/Placement - Authorized on Plan	\$2,000
Milestone 2 - One Month Job Retention - Authorized on Plan	\$1,000
Milestone 3 - Job Stabilization/Transition to Extended Follow Along	\$1,000
Milestone 4 - Successful Case Closure - Authorized on Plan	\$2,250
High Quality Indicators (If two of the following are met: 25 or more hours per week, wage at or above \$10/hour, health insurance benefits available)	Additional \$1,000 at the time of Milestone 4 payment

Job Readiness, Development and Placement Services

Type of Service	Rate
Job Readiness Training (maximum of 30 days)	\$50/day
Job Placement: after 7 th day of employment	\$1,000
Job Placement: after 90 th day of successful employment	\$1,500
High Quality Indicators (If two of the following are met: 30 or more hours per week, wage at or above \$12/hour, health insurance benefits available)	\$1,000

Time-Limited Job Coaching Services

Time Limited Job Coaching is for individuals with significant disabilities who do not require extended follow-along services but need short-term job training and support(s). In addition, Time Limited Job Coaching does not require the same length of job training as supported employment. Time-Limited Job Coaching is viewed as a level of training slightly more intensive than on-the-job training and less intensive than supported employment training.

Transition from School to Work Services

Type of Service	Rate
Workplace Readiness Training and Instruction on Self Advocacy Maximum of 64 sessions total (each type of service has its own limit on sessions). Session comprised of 45-90 minutes of instructional time. Only one service can be provided per session	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • \$50 per session • Not to exceed \$3,200 per student
Work-Based Learning Experiences - Paid Reimbursement cannot exceed 240 hours per employer for a maximum of two different employer placements (480 hours total per student). Reimbursement is made up to a 40 hour work week	The rate of reimbursement is equal to the student's salary up to \$8.00 per hour plus 9.33% for social security, Medicare, and unemployment taxes.
Job Shadowing A one-on-one 3-5-hour observation of a specific job and its duties at a business in the community. Maximum of two Job Shadow experience at two different sites	Up to \$200 per Job Shadow Experience
Employer Site Visits <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Visits to a business or businesses with a group of two or more students to allow them to tour the business, get information on how to apply, etc. Maximum of two Employer Site Visits at two different sites 	Up to \$75 per Employer Site Visit
Assistive Technology Devices/Support Services/Uniforms (Employers may be reimbursed for services if required in order for the employer to provide the Work-Based Learning Experience)	Up to \$500 employer reimbursement



On the Job Training Services

The rate of reimbursement is equal to the consumer's monthly base salary. Reimbursement is made up to a forty (40) hour work week. The Counselor will set up on-the-job training on a Plan for a period of time not to exceed three (3) months.
